

Squash Talent Foundation Programme 2024/25-Advanced Training Course

Note to Participants

1. Please wear appropriate sport attire and non-marking shoes. And prepare your own squash racket and protective eyewear to wear during the class.
2. All the participants of Advanced Training Course 2024-25 will be automatically entered into Novice Competition, except the followings:
 - Participants who are/have once been training in either Young Athletes Squash Training Scheme or Joint School Training Centre or Regional Squad of Year 2024-25 and 2025-26 Phase 1, are not allowed to take part in the Novice Competition.
 - All the past Top 4 winners of this novice competition within 3 years (2021/22 – 2023/24) may not contest for his/her winning age category again.
3. Draw result of the Novice competition will be released via Squash Association of Hong Kong, China official website on 9 May 2025. Participants please download the draws from the website directly. .
4. No change of class and/or withdrawal would be accepted. Additionally, no refund will be arranged for the successful participants.
5. When Typhoon Signal No.8 or above is hoisted within TWO hours prior to a scheduled outdoor / indoor activity, such activity must be cancelled and will be rescheduled When Typhoon Signal No.3 or below / Yellow or Red Rainstorm Warning is hoisted within TWO hours prior to a scheduled outdoor / indoor activity, such activity will be held as scheduled. No supplementary class will be arranged.
6. Please read the “Bad Weather Arrangement” at the back of this letter.

All decisions made in this programme are rightfully under the discretion of the Squash Association of Hong Kong, China.

In the event of discrepancies between the English and Chinese versions, the Chinese version shall prevail.

Bad Weather Arrangements

1. Typhoon Signal No.8 or above

- When Typhoon Signal No.8 or above is hoisted within TWO hours prior to the activity starts, such activity must be cancelled and will be re-scheduled; and
- As soon as the Typhoon Signal No. 8 is hoisted, all activities must be ceased immediately and participants must return home or take shelter in a safe place.
- Re-scheduling of assessment will be announced by our staff in-charge in due course.

2. Black Rainstorm Warning

- When Black Rainstorm Warning is hoisted within TWO hours prior to the activity starts, such activity must be cancelled and will be re-scheduled.
- As advised by the Government, people should take shelter in a safe place during a Black Rainstorm Warning. Therefore, if the Black Rainstorm Warning is hoisted when the indoor activity are already in progress, the assessment will continue unless otherwise announced by the Association.
- If the warning is still in force when the activity ends, participants are advised to stay at the activity venue for their own safety until the warning has been removed or the traffic and weather conditions have been improved.
- Re-scheduling of assessment will be advised by our staff in-charge in due course.

3. Typhoon Signal No.3 or below / Yellow & Red Rainstorm Warning

- When Typhoon Signal No.3 or below / Yellow or Red Rainstorm Warning is hoisted within TWO hours prior to the activity starts, such activity will be held as scheduled. No re-scheduling of assessment will be arranged.

Remarks:

- Parents should decide on their own accord whether their children would participate in our activities under various weather and traffic conditions.
- If the above stated procedures are not followed, no re-scheduling of assessment will be arranged for absence.
