

## **Hong Kong Junior Squash Award Scheme – Remark**

- 1) The assessment information such as Name, Date, Reporting time and Group of participants will be upload to our official website on the announcement date, and **we will not notify the participant by post individually.**
- 2) Fitness test will be assessed after completion of the skill and technique test for each group.
- 3) All test takers **must** have an acceptable and valid ID with a photograph (student id card, ID card or student handbook) and report to the organizer in accordance to the above scheduled time. **Late arrival will NOT be entertained.**
- 4) It is reminded that you are required to provide your own squash racket and wear appropriate sport attire and non-marking shoes. Protective eyewear is recommended to wear during the assessment but not a must.
- 5) **No re-fund** will be made once the application is accepted.
- 6) Administration fee of HK\$60 will be charged for the reissued award certificate or/ and badge.
- 7) No re-schedule of assessment will be allowed only if **the original doctor's certificate or its copy (dated on the assessment day) is provided within one week after the assessment date to our office either by fax 28690118 or in-person.**
- 8) Assessment result will be subjected to the final decision of the in-charge assessor.
- 9) Please read the information of "Bad Weather Arrangement" in the attachment.
- 10) Applicants who are unqualified or submit incomplete applications will be disqualified.

All decisions made in this scheme are rightfully under the discretion of Squash Association of Hong Kong, China.

## **Hong Kong Junior Squash Award Scheme**

### **Bad Weather Arrangements**

#### **1. Typhoon Signal No.8 or above**

- When Typhoon Signal No.8 or above is hoisted within TWO hours (7:45am – 9:45am) prior to the activity starts, such activity must be cancelled and will be re-scheduled; and
- As soon as the Typhoon Signal No. 8 is hoisted, all activities must be ceased immediately and participants must return home or take shelter in a safe place.
- Re-scheduling of assessment will be announced by our staff in-charge in due course.

#### **2. Black Rainstorm Warning**

- When Black Rainstorm Warning is hoisted within TWO hours (7:45am – 9:45am) prior to the activity starts, such activity must be cancelled and will be re-scheduled.
- As advised by the Government, people should take shelter in a safe place during a Black Rainstorm Warning. Therefore, if the Black Rainstorm Warning is hoisted when the indoor activity are already in progress, the assessment will continue unless otherwise announced by the Association.
- If the warning is still in force when the activity ends, participants are advised to stay at the activity venue for their own safety until the warning has been removed or the traffic and weather conditions have been improved.
- Re-scheduling of assessment will be advised by our staff in-charge in due course.

#### **3. Typhoon Signal No.3 or below / Yellow & Red Rainstorm Warning**

- When Typhoon Signal No.3 or below / Yellow or Red Rainstorm Warning is hoisted within TWO hours (7:45am – 9:45am) prior to the activity starts, such activity will be held as scheduled. No re-scheduling of assessment will be arranged.

#### **Remarks:**

- Parents should decide on their own accord whether their children would participate in our activities under various weather and traffic conditions.
- If the above stated procedures are not followed, no re-scheduling of assessment will be arranged for absence.
